While many perceive Revelation as a prophecy of future events, these letters, addressed to real, historical churches, reveal insights that resonate just as powerfully today as they did in the 1st Century. As we navigate our search for new pastors, this series invites us to reflect on the challenges and guidance offered to these early Christian communities and to discern together what kind of church we are called to be in this pivotal moment in our history and that of the world.
