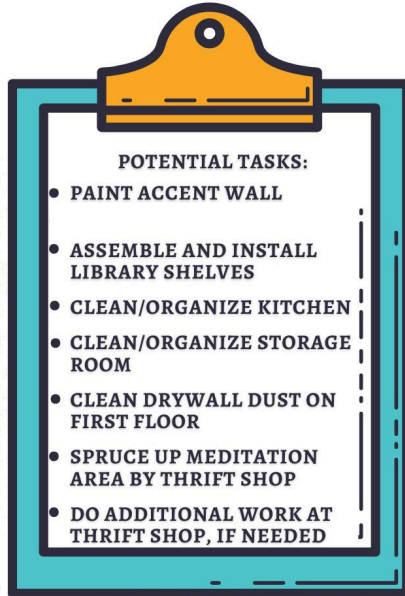
Our Thrift Shop is open Tuesdays, Thursdays and Saturdays from 9 am until noon. Please note, donations are not being accepted at this time.
