Together We Rise (TWR) Update

Most of the major work on restoring our Church from the hurricanes last fall has been completed. The repairs were financed from a \$200,000 Disaster Line of Credit for the cleanup work and a \$534,000 Loan, both from the UCC. In addition we have received \$345,614 in donations from 95 donors. The amount of pledges and non-pledged donations at this point represents 40% of the \$1.7 million we will spend to complete the total restoration, including paying off the loans we have used so far. Thanks to all of you who have contributed and urge everyone to join us in sharing your financial resources to retire our debt.
