Hetty Jackson/Dr. Martin Lewis Scholarship • Deadline May 15

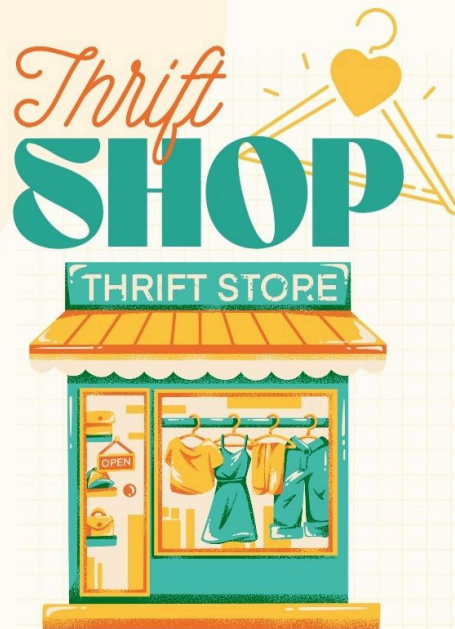
