### Pentecost • Sunday, May 24

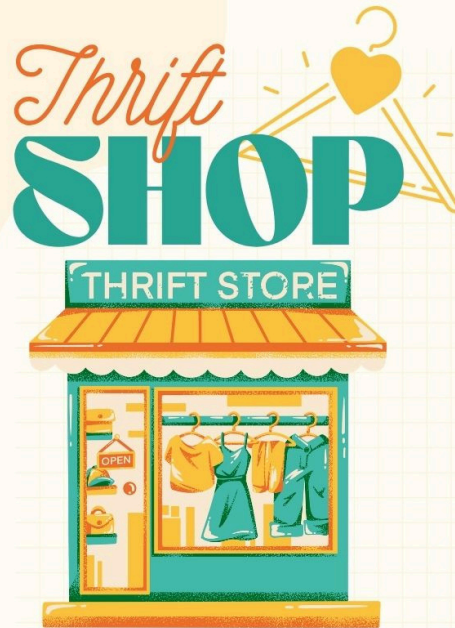
In celebration of Pentecost, we ask that you please wear RED to worship service on Sunday, May 24th.
